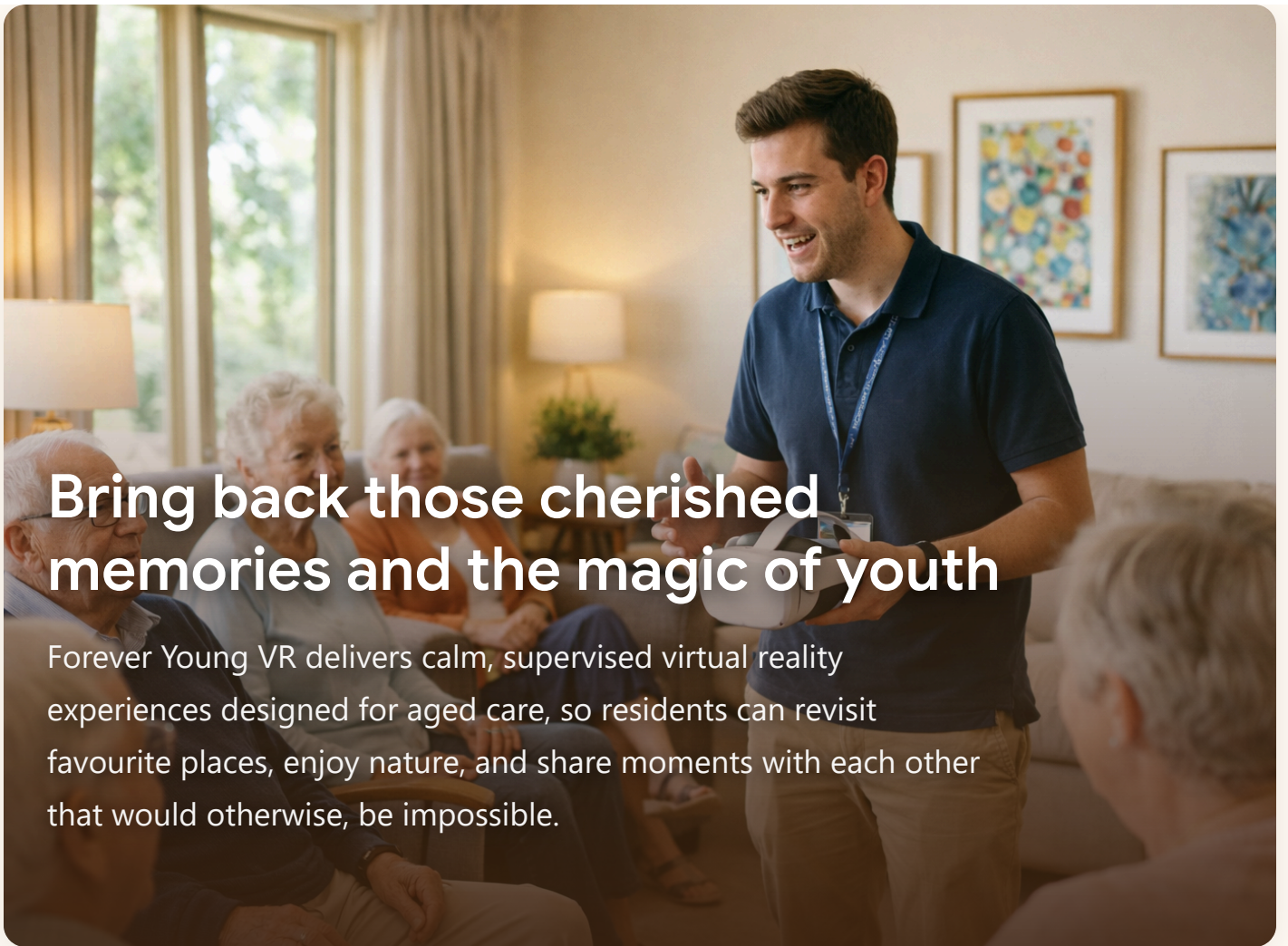

We partner with residential aged care and day programs across the region. Sessions are paced for comfort, with trained facilitators and content chosen for seniors.

Why VR in aged care?

Virtual reality opens doors to connection and wonder. It can awaken cherished memories, spark lively conversation, and transport residents to new and forgotten places, all without leaving the comfort and safety of their home. The joy spreads beyond the headset too; many residents love watching friends explore virtual worlds, turning each session into a shared, social experience filled with laughter and curiosity.



What you can expect

Trained facilitators

Setup, hygiene, and pacing handled by people who work every day with older adults.

Senior-friendly content

Scenic drives, gardens, travel, music, and reminiscence experiences—no fast motion or surprises.

Flexible visits

One-off demos, regular rounds, or special events for families and open days.



Built around community

We design each visit so non-wearers can take part—mirroring to a screen, group discussion, and time to swap stories about what everyone saw.

Choice, consent, and breaks. Every session is optional and can stop at any time.

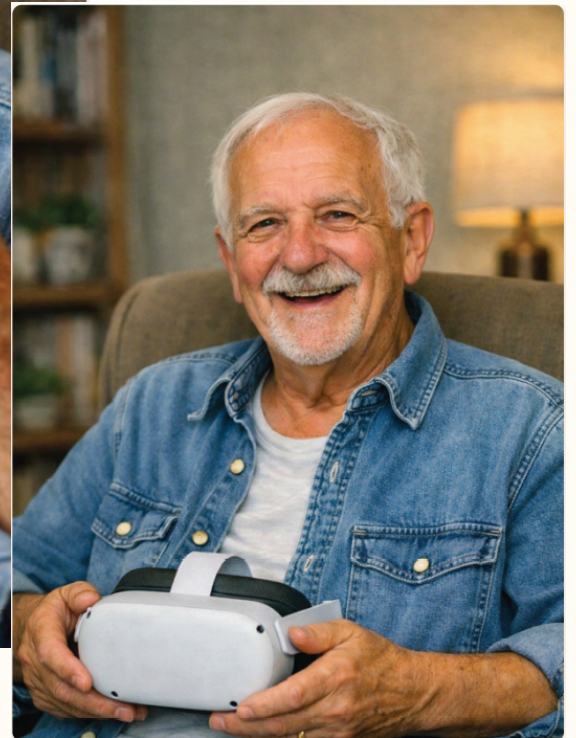


An anniversary surprise
